



Kids Ministry Director (Part-time)

Job Description

Orchard Kids is currently seeking to hire a part-time individual for our Waverly Campus to facilitate Sunday morning programming for the 9:15 and 10:30 services. We are offering 10-15 hours per week with a flexible work schedule. The position partners with families to create spiritual oversight for kids in Nursery through 6th grade. You must have a personal relationship with Jesus, a heart for children, and a desire for relational ministry.

Main Responsibilities

1. Recruit volunteers
2. Oversee Sunday morning programming
3. Participate in events as assigned/agreed upon by coach

Recruit volunteers

Volunteers are critical to accomplishing the mission. In this role you can expect to personally ask people to serve in Kids Ministry, provide coaching and encouragement to volunteers, and assist with volunteer celebrations.

Oversee Sunday morning programming

We utilize Orange Curriculum for Kids Ministry on Sunday mornings which has large group and small group settings. When executing curriculum, you can expect to gather/organize materials for small/large group activities, communicate weekly lesson plans with volunteers, and coordinate large group time.

Participate in events as assigned/agreed upon by coach

This position reports to the Waverly Campus Leader and is supported by the Cedar Falls Campus Kids Ministry Team. Together, you will coordinate involvement with staff meetings, community VBS in Waverly, Christmas Eve services, Easter, Global Leadership Summit, OHC Leadership Huddles, and Fall/Winter Ministry Kickoff events.

1. Are you willing and do you feel called by God to use your spiritual gifts and God-given passions to lead the church?

- Will you pray regularly for the church?
- Will you make your responsibilities a high priority and serve Christ by taking assignments when needed?
- Will you faithfully work to accomplish the tasks of your role within the church?

2. Are you committed to your own personal spiritual growth and the spiritual growth of others?

- Will you regularly be involved in services, classes, and programs which will help you to grow towards being a fully devoted follower of Christ?
- If married, will you encourage the spiritual growth of your spouse?
- If you are a parent, will you strive to keep the baptism vows of your children and/or keep your commitments to God to raise them in faith?
- Are you committed to developing a Christ-like character, working to increasingly demonstrate the fruit of the spirit in your life?

3. Are you currently lovingly and faithfully living within your heterosexual marriage or chastely living as a single person?

- Are you intentionally choosing, as a Christian, to limit sexual relationships to a heterosexual marriage?
- Are you avoiding pornography?
- If you have been divorced, has that been confessed and forgiven, and if remarried, are you living faithfully with your current spouse?

4. Are you committed to being a faithful steward of your resources of time, talents, and money?

- Are you conscientiously working to meet the responsibilities within your family, including all dependents?
- Is an appropriate proportion of your resources being used to support the work and mission of Orchard Hill Church?
- Are you willing to identify your spiritual gifts and God-given passions in order to serve Christ's church?
- Are you regularly paying your bills and are you conducting your financial and business affairs in an honorable and truthful manner?

5. Are you currently involved in anything that could bring disgrace or dishonor to Christ or His church?

- Are there unresolved or unrepented sins in your past?
 - Is there current behavior in your life which is repetitively immoral or illegal?
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Jesus Christ said in Matthew 16:18: "...I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it."
